

Introduction of the Kafue Gorge Regional Training Centre and the collaboration with the EELA project

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 The Kafue Gorge Regional Training Centre (KGRTC), is a registered trust in Zambia, controlled by a regional Board of Trustees (BOT) from Malawi, Eswatini, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia and Zimbabwe.

 KGRTC operates independently with 63 members of staff on its establishment.



KGRTC is located in Namalundu, Chikankata District, Southern Province, about one 100km south of Zambia's capital Lusaka and 28km off the Kafue-Chirundu Road.





- It is in the same vicinity as Zambia's largest hydropower station the ZESCO 990MW Kafue Gorge (Upper) Power Station.
- KGRTC was established in 1989, with the support of Sida, NORAD and ZESCO, to provide competitive specialized training solutions in hydropower and related fields to electricity utilities in the Southern African Development Community (SADC) and Sub-Saharan regions.









- KGRTC is ISO 9001 Quality Management Systems certified.
- It is Grade One registered institution with the Technical Education, Vocational and Entrepreneurship Training Authority (TEVETA) of Zambia.
- It has also been recognised as a Centre of Excellence for TVET Training in Zambia by TEVETA and as a Centre of excellence for training in electricity in Africa by the Association of Power Utilities in Africa (APUA).



















KGRTC is a **fully-fledged training facility** providing both indoor and outdoor training in technical and non-technical areas.
